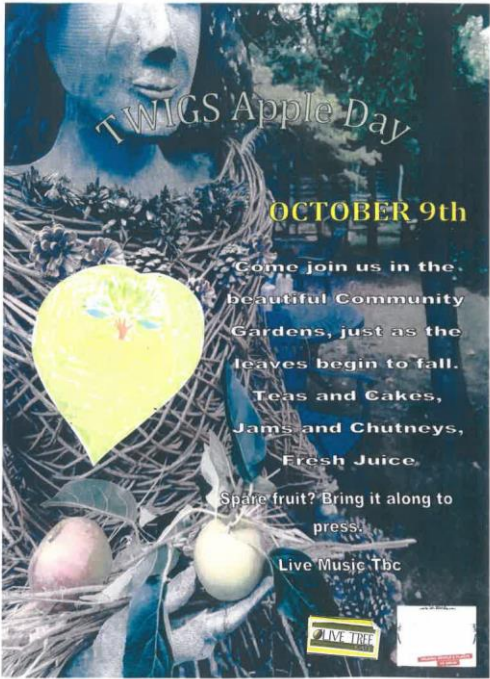

The Olive Tree is working with Shine Pinehurst to get the Pinecones café up and running again. Craft workshops, a lunch club and the Monday bakery are already underway.

Over at Twigs, members of the National Citizenship Scheme are helping to create a wildlife pond in the Haven. FoT will be helping to pay for the aquatic plants needed for it.
